
COVID FAQ Corner

Q: My child tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days. We plan on visiting colleges within that 90 days out of state. Does my child still have to quarantine after travel if they have tested positive in the past 90 davs?

A: Check with your school district about returning to inperson instruction. At this time, an individual who tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 3 months does not need to quarantine after exposure or travel.

Updates from the Governor's Office

- General indoor gatherings must be limited to 10 people, general outdoor gatherings must be limited to 25 people.
- Effective immediately, houses of worship and religious services can operate at 50% capacity. Masks are required and members of different households must always be at least six feet apart.
 - o Indoor gatherings for religious services and celebrations, including wedding ceremonies, funerals and memorial services that involve a religious service must be limited to 50% of a room's capacity.
 - o Wedding ceremonies, funerals, and memorial services that do not involve a religious service must be limited to 35% of a room's capacity, but no more than 150 individuals.
- Effective immediately, indoor and outdoor collegiate sports practices and competitions may allow two parents or guardians per participating athlete as spectators. Numbers cannot exceed 35% of the indoor room's capacity and social distancing must be maintained outdoors.
- Starting March 1st, sports, and entertainment venues with a fixed seating capacity of over 5,000 people may open for spectators. 10% for indoor venues, 15% for outdoor venues.
