Updates from the Governor's Office

Effective May 19th:

- The ban on interstate youth sports competitions will be lifted.
- No limit on outdoor gatherings, but attendees would still be required to remain 6 feet apart from other groups.
- Increase in indoor gathering limits to 50 persons.
- Complete removal of all percentage capacity limits for indoor and outdoor businesses, and houses of worship subject to social distancing.
- Increase in indoor large venue capacity to 30%

Expansion of Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine to Ages 12+ Effective immediately, Points of Dispensing (PODs) can immediately begin administration of the Pfizer BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine to persons 12 and older.

On Monday, May 10th the FDA issues a <u>revised</u> <u>Emergency Use Authorization (EUA)</u> and on Wednesday, May 12th the CDC adopted the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices' (ACIP) recommendations for the expanded age group including 12–15-year-old individuals. <u>Click here</u> to read a statement from Commissioner Pesichilli.

At-Home COVID-19 Test Kits

A variety of home-based COVID-19 test kits are becoming more widely available. While all involve self-collection, some kits require a prescription and other are over-the-counter (OTC). Some testing may be observed by a telehealth provider. Some kits are sent to a laboratory for processing, and some do not involve a healthcare provider at all. While these options are accessible and affordable, test results may not be reported to public health which means public health measures like self-isolating and notifying contacts is up to the positive individual.
