

FDA and CDC Clears Moderna Boosters and "Mix and Match" Approach for COVID-19 Vaccines

On October 20, 2021 the <u>US FDA took action</u> to expand the use of a booster dose for COVID-19 vaccines in eligible populations. The CDC followed up this endorsement on <u>October 21st</u>. The Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) will now allow:

- The use of a single booster dose of Moderna COVID-19 vaccine that may be administered at least <u>6 months</u> after completion of primary series to individuals:
 - ° 65 years of age and older.
 - ° 18-64 years of age at high risk of severe COVID-19.
 - 18-64 years of age with frequent institutional or occupational exposure to COVID-19.
 - The Moderna booster is <u>half the dose</u> that is administered for a primary series dose.
- The use of single booster of J&J may be administered at least <u>2 months</u> after completion of a single-dose primary regimen to individuals 18 years and older.
 - The J&J booster is the <u>same dose size</u> as the primary regimen dose.
- The use of each of the available COVID-19 as heterologous (different or "mix and match") booster dose in eligible individuals following completion of primary vaccination with a different available COVID-19 vaccine:
 - For example, individuals who received J&J prior may receive a single booster dose of Pfizer or Moderna (half dose) at least 2 months after their J&J primary vaccine.
 - Moderna primary recipients may receive a Pfizer booster and Pfizer primary recipients may receive a Moderna booster (half dose) at least <u>6 months</u> after completing their primary series.
 - Moderna and Pfizer primary recipients may receive a J&J booster at least <u>6 months</u> after completing their primary series.
- A single booster dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine may be administered at least <u>6 months</u> after the completion of the primary series to individuals 18-64 years of age with frequent institutional or occupational exposure to COVID-19.
