Free N95 Masks

The Strategic National Stockpile has distributed roughly 400 million free N95 respirators to pharmacy distribution centers throughout the country. Retail pharmacies participating in this program will vary by state and territory. As of today 1/27, pharmacies like Walgreens, Walmart, CVS and Rite Aid hope to have the masks in as soon as early February for residents. Customers will be able to pick up a limit of 3 masks per person while supplies last. Distribution will vary by location. [Learn more about the free N95s here](#).

Docket Access and Vaccine Card Issues

After receiving a COVID-19 vaccine it's easy to tuck that small white vaccine card away somewhere for "safe-keeping". It's also just as easy to lose track of where you stored your card. Luckily, getting a duplicate vaccine card or utilizing the Docket app on your phone to view your COVID-19 vaccine record is easy!

If you lose your COVID-19 vaccination card, you can request your immunization record by visiting the NJ Immunization Information System ([NJIS](#)). Once on this page:

1. Click on "Submit a Request" from the top blue ribbon.
2. Click "I want to request a copy of my immunization record from NJIS". Attach a copy of your photo ID.
3. If you wish to have a copy of the COVID-19 vaccine lot number, please write this in the description section of the ticket.
4. Click "send" to submit your request which will be processed within 24-48 business hours.

You can also call the location where you received your vaccine from to get a duplicate card. For example, if you were vaccinated at one of BTHD clinics and need a new card, you can call 908-204-3070 to request a new copy. **Note:** You **must** have received at least **one** dose from that location to receive a new copy. For example, if you received all 3 doses at Walgreens you cannot request the BTHD for a new copy.

[Docket](#) is a free app from the NJDOH that makes it easy for everyone to securely access their COVID-19 vaccination record by directly connecting with NJIS. Currently you can only view COVID-19 doses in Docket, not complete vaccination history.

You can access your COVID-19 immunization records and export PDFs if needed. At this time there is not an option to view a QR code but Docket has plans to roll out this feature soon. The Docket app is free and available in the [App store](#) or on [Google Play](#) in English or Spanish depending on Smartphone settings.

If you are having trouble locating your record in Docket, there may be an error with your name or other information. Try searching using multiple combinations of your name - including with and without punctuation if applicable. If you are unable to access your record via Docket, put in a request to [NJIS](#). You may also reach out to Riya Patel at the BTHD at 908-204-3068 for NJIS specific questions.
