The Bernards Township free rabies vaccination clinic is scheduled for Saturday, January 14, 2022 from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM. It will be held at the Bernards Township Public Works Garage 277 South Maple Avenue Basking Ridge, New Jersey 07920.

As a reminder ALL Bernards Township dogs and cats must be licensed, as per NJ statue 4:19-15.2a and Bernards Township Ordinance BH:10-5.2. All current dog and cat licenses expire on January 31st of each year. The licensing of animals is an important aspect of rabies and animal control. Please mail all pet licenses to the Bernards Township Health Department at 262 S. Finley Ave Basking Ridge, NJ 07920.

In order for a license to be issued, the owner must present proof that a licensed veterinarian has vaccinated the dog / cat against rabies and that the duration of immunity from that vaccination extends through at least 10 months of the twelvemonth licensing period. An exemption to the rabies inoculation requirement shall be granted if the owner presents written certification from a licensed veterinarian that the dog/cat cannot be vaccinated due to a medical condition or course of therapy.

The rabies expiration date for your pet can be found on your current Bernards Township dog/cat license. If you are unsure of the expiration date call or email Michelle Santoro, Bernards Township Animal Control Officer at MSantoro@Bernards.org or call 908-204-3066.
