#### **COVID-19 Third Doses vs Boosters**

# **Everything you need to** know about COVID-19...



# **Third Doses** People are eligible if they:

(1) Received 2 doses of the

#### Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine AND

(2) are moderately to severely immunocompromised\*

# **Boosters**

People are eligible if they:

- (1) Received 2 doses of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine
- (2) are **65+**, <u>OR</u> a long term care resident, OR 18+ with high risk of severe COVID-19 due to underlying health conditions or workplace exposure\*\*?

Why

Who

Helps protect those who did not build enough protection with 2-dose vaccination

Eligible starting 28 days after second dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine

Helps protect those with healthy immune systems whose protection from vaccination has decreased over time

Fligible starting 6 months after second dose of Pfizer vaccine

Boosters have not vet been approved for those who received the Moderna or J&J vaccine, due to a

lack of sufficient data. If you received the Moderna or J&J vaccine, stay tuned for further information on booster approval.

Immunocompromised = an individual with a weakened immune system due to certain health conditions \*\*For example healthcare workers, teachers and others whose job puts them at risk of severe COVID-19

# **COVID-19 Vaccine and Seasonal Flu Shots**

As the weather begins to get colder, seasonal flu starts to circulate in our communities. According to Dr. Priya Sampathkumar from the Mayo Clinic, "In most places, flu starts circulating by November and December. So it's recommended that everyone complete their flu vaccine by October. And now is the right time to start getting flu vaccine".

If you haven't been vaccinated for COVID-19 yet or need a booster or third dose, you can get your flu shot and get vaccinated for COVID at the same time. Getting the flu shot doesn't protect people against COVID-19 and getting vaccinated for COVID-19 doesn't protect people against getting the flu.
